The Scandinavian Association for Language and Cognition Governing Board meeting

Date: June 12, 2018

Hour: 13:00 (i.e. 14:00 Finnish time)

Present: Marlene Johansson Falck (MJF), Line Burholt Kristensen (LBK), Kristian Tylén (KT), Esa Penttilä (EP), Sara Farshchi (SF, left at 13:40) and Mikko Höglund (MH)

1. The meeting is opened by SALC's President

SALC president MJF opened the meeting at 13:02.

2. Appointment of chair for the meeting

MJF was appointed chair of the meeting.

3. Appointment of keeper of the minutes

MH was appointed keeper of the minutes.

4. Approval of the agenda

The agenda was approved with the one change that treasurer's account was moved earlier.

5. Appointment of two members to check the minutes

MJF & KT were appointed to check the minutes.

6. Treasurer's account (SF)

- Two new members
- SALC has currently 15 580 SEK balance on the bank account.
- SF will take over the payment of the SALC website.

7. SALC conference in Aarhus (KT)

- 1st CFP in late July/early August
- The local organizing committee has met and discussed the suggested plenaryists (see Appendix).
 - The idea was to balance between the profile of Aarhus and different topics.
 - KT introduced the suggestions for the five plenaryists (see Appendix).
- MJF raised the question about money and whether we/Aarhus can afford the travel costs, and it was concluded and it should not be a problem as they are not from overseas.
- Decisions about travel grants to students was postponed, but it was decided to announce at least a few, and also reward the best student paper like in Lund at SALC 6.
- SALC-sponsored plenaryist was discussed, and it was decided to ask Ewa Dąbrowska, with Semino and Divjak as back-ups (see Appendix).

- It was decided that the five plenarists suggested by the organizing committee are suitable, and KT will start the invitation process.
- The date for the conference is set: May 22-24, 2018.
- KT will look into funding opportunities for a pre-conference workshop.
- MJF and LBK raised the question of theme sessions and the deadline for the proposals, and it was decided that the deadline is earlier than for the general session papers: theme sessions in November, general session in December (see Appendix).
- When CFP is ready, KT will distribute it to the board, who will then distribute it through their own channels, in order to get as much coverage as possible.

8. Regional extension of SALC (EP)

- The principles for extension were written down in 2017 before SALC 6, and EP and LBK will make them now available on the SALC website, so that interested parties/countries can see them and contact SALC.

9. Minutes on the homepage

- LBK will add the latest minutes on the homepage.

10. Next board meeting

The next board meeting will be held early October. MJF will send out a doodle in early September.

11. The meeting is closed by the chair of the meeting


